This recipient of the Wright Brothers “Master Pilot” Award began flying in 1952 at Jennings Brothers Air Service located at T.F.Green Airport.

He obtained his Private Pilot Certificate from Designated Pilot Examiner, Walter Larson at RI-Conn Airport in 1953.

In 1959 Bob obtained his Commercial Pilot Certificate, and then the following year, in 1960, he earned both his Instrument Rating and his Certified Flight Instructor Rating.

He instructed for East Air Corporation from 1960 to 1963.

Bob also did “Fish Spotting” from 1960 to 1968, off the coast of Massachusetts.

In 1966 Mohawk Airlines hired Bob. Mohawk became Alleghany which became USAir, and finally USAirways. Bob retired from USAirways in 1994.

Since 1994 Bob has owned and operated Lincoln Flight Center located at North Central Airport, where he continues to display and teach his love for aviation every day.

This recipient of the Wright Brothers “Master Pilot” Award truly exemplifies the title of Master Pilot. His pilot certificate contains the following ratings and limitations: Commercial Pilot-Airplane Single Engine Land, Single Engine Sea and Glider. Airline Transport Pilot- Convair 240,340, 440, Fairchild 227, British Aerospace BAC 111, Douglas DC-9, Boeing 757 and Boeing 767. He is also a Certified Flight Instructor and Instrument Instructor.
